Mission Statement

The Washoe County School District provides each student the opportunity to achieve his or her potential through a superior education in a safe and challenging environment in order to develop responsible and productive citizens for our diverse and rapidly changing community.

Superintendent's Highlights

During the 2008-09 school year, the WCSD Board of Trustees adopted its revised Blueprint for Student Success. This district planning document lays out the vision and mission of the school district, its key goal areas and the performance indicators that will be used to judge success of district efforts. As part of the Blueprint, the Board of Trustees highlighted 11 key action areas as a focus for the 2008-09 and 2009-10 school years.

As part of the revision of the Blueprint, district administration with the support of the Board of Trustees has instituted a continuous improvement cycle. This cycle highlights Board and administrative actions to be taken throughout the year in order to evaluate progress, plan for change, implement action steps, and to monitor implementation. The timing of the cycle positions the district to make well informed and advanced decisions predicated on progress and time to make mid-course corrections when necessary. It enables the district to move away from a reactionary mode of decision making. This puts the district in an optimal position to support its schools and students and to meet its overarching achievement goals.

The overarching achievement goal identified in the Blueprint for Success is "while maintaining rigorous academic standards, every child in the district will graduate career and/or college ready." To fulfill the district's mission and to achieve its goal, the Blueprint points to the critical need to build academic success among its students. Academic success can only be improved by building human capital, community capital, and by continuously improving facilities and support services. The Board of Trustees annually monitors performance indicators aligned to each of these focal areas.

Building Academic Success

Blueprint Action Areas

- Continued implementation/ evaluation of the Gateway Course of Study.
- Implement Response to Intervention (RTI) using data and differentiated instruction to meet the needs of all learners.
- Create successful transitions to high school for freshman success.
- Implement a parent involvement plan in every school focused on improving student academic success.

Performance Outcomes

- Although there was a modest decline in performance among 3rd grade students when comparing 2008 to 2007, the long term trend in reading and math performance among 3rd grade students is significant and positive.
- With respect to the long term trend, achievement increases in reading and math among the 3rd grade population has been observed for all ethnic groups and special populations.
- The 3-year trend among 6th grade students in both reading and math is modest and positive, giving reason for optimism.
- Approximately 45% to 50% of students scoring non-proficient in reading and math in grade 3 scored proficient as 6th grade students.
- Nearly 45% of students scoring non-proficient in writing in grade 4 (2004 school year) scored proficient in writing as 8th grade students.
- Significant percentages of students transitioning between 6th to 7th grade and from 7th to 8th grade have moved from non-proficiency status to proficiency status in both reading and math.
- All comprehensive high schools, with the exception of one, made AYP in the 2007-08 school year.
- All comprehensive high schools met the Jay Mathews Challenge Index based on the percentages of students taking AP examinations.
- During the 2008-09 school year there has been a significant decrease in the 9th grade credit deficiency rate.
- There continues to be a significant increase in the percentage of IEP students earning standard high school diplomas.

Building Human Capital

Blueprint Action Areas

- Implement a plan to improve classroom teacher attendance.
- Implement a plan to recruit, hire, and retain a quality and diverse workforce.

Performance Outcomes

- Through its recruiting efforts, in critical operational areas including transportation, custodial services, substitute teacher services, nutrition services, the School District has seen a significant increase in the applicant pool and at the same time has observed a significant decrease in employee turnover.
- In the 2007-08 school year, the School District observed a significant decrease (approximately a 2.5% reduction) in the number of unfilled teacher absences.
- In order to boost our ability to recruit highly qualified teachers, the School District increased the entry level salary for teachers and has negotiated the ability for new teachers to receive up to ten (10) years of past experience on the salary schedule. Previous past experience credit, other than for Nevada teachers, was five (5) years.
- The school district continues to work toward and has seen a narrowing of the gap between Title I and non-Title I schools in terms of teacher experience and the percentage of teachers with advanced educational degrees.
- In Title I schools the School District has observed an increase in the percentage of classes being taught by highly qualified teachers and in 2007, 100% of Title I Paraprofessionals were highly qualified.

Building Community Capital

Blueprint Action Areas

- Align strategic partnerships with local businesses and civic organizations to further WCSD goals.
- Implement a plan to effectively communicate with our culturally and economically diverse community.

Performance Outcomes

- To increase communication, the District released the initial issue of BOARDcast to approximately 8,000 community members. Additional expanded releases are planned.
- To more fully engage and effectively communicate with the community, the, the Board of Trustees met recently with 30 community groups and organizations in "Listen to Learn" sessions. These sessions promote two-way communication and provide the Board direct community input on key issues.
- A 2008 scientific sampling of Washoe County voters and parents on a wide variety of educational issues and perceptions showed that 42% of voters and 57% of parents reported that the District currently does a good to excellent job of keeping them informed. The District will use this baseline data to target improvement.
- The District's Parental Involvement Council conducted an extensive survey of parents of parents regarding their perceptions of their own school's parental involvement efforts. More than 16,000 returned surveys provided valuable baseline data and revealed that 85% of elementary parents, 63.6% of middle school parents, and 71.4% of high school parents report that their school sees "parents as important partners." Additionally, 59% of elementary parents, 42% of middle school parents and 52% of high school parents report volunteering at their child's school at least once during the school year.
- To engage the community a successful pilot "Principal For A Day" program was conducted.

Facilities & Support Services

Blueprint Action Areas

- Implement plan to ensure building projects will be completed on time and on budget.
- Develop and implement a 21st Century student-centered technology infrastructure.
- Implement the district continuous improvement cycle as part of the ongoing CSI implementation.

Performance Outcomes

- We anticipate that for the eighth year in a row, the school district was awarded the Government Finance Officers' Association Certificate of Excellence in Financial Reporting.
- External auditors awarded an unqualified opinion on the school district's audit report—"Best That Can Be Achieved."
- For the 11th out of the past 12 years, the school district received an Achievement of Excellence in Procurement award for 2008.
- The District currently has bond ratings of Aa2 from Moody's Investors Service, AA from Standard and Poor's Rating Service and AA- from Fitch Ratings. These ratings were affirmed when the District issued bonds in February 2009. These ratings are among the highest ratings for school districts in Nevada.
- A Document Management System for electronically capturing, storing, and retrieving official documents was implemented in nine departments.
- The school district implemented a new assessment reporting system designed to put data in the hands of teachers in a timely manner to assist them in instructional decision making.
- In the first year of measuring energy efficiency and a concerted effort to increase energy efficiency, the school district achieved a 3.8% reduction on the energy utilization index (btu/sf).
- To ensure that all facilities are up to cleanliness standards, the school district uses the "Building Interior-Cleanliness Performance Evaluation." One of the benefits of the performance evaluation is that the school district can identify specific cleaning tasks that are not up to standard to better focus retraining efforts.
- The District's Nutrition Services program was recognized in recent testimony to the legislature for their efforts in operating this program in a profitable manner. The program was also recognized for continuing its efforts to promote breakfast.

Goals and Objectives

- All students will be proficient in reading, writing, and math as they transition between middle school and high school.
 - There will be a 3% to 5% increase in the student proficiency rate in math, reading, and writing as measured by state assessments in grades 3, 5, 6, and 8 for all students.
- All students will graduate from high school career and or college ready.
 - There will be a 3% to 5% increase in graduation rates for all students as measured by the cohort graduation rate method.
 - There will be a 1% to 2% decrease in dropout rates for all students.
- All students will be provided a well-rounded education.
- Schools will provide a safe and orderly environment maximizing the opportunities for all students to achieve their academic potential.
- All schools will include parent involvement activities in their annual school improvement plans based on the six standards for parent involvement and focused on improving student achievement.
- All students will have the opportunity to learn in a high quality educational environment that is supported by highly qualified administrators, educators, and educational support personnel.
 - There will be a 1% increase in the substitute teacher fill rate.
- Enhance strategic partnerships between WCSD and local business and civic organizations by implementing the WCSD Communication Plan.
- Optimize the learning environment for students through the strengthening of facilities and support services.
- All school building construction projects will be completed on time and on budget.
- Classroom equipment used for educational delivery, such as interactive whiteboards and sound field enhancement systems, will be repaired within a time period established to minimize learning disruptions.
- All district facilities will be managed and operated in an efficient manner to reduce utility consumption and environmental pollution while providing students a learning model for environmental and resource conservation awareness.
- All students will be transported safely and efficiently to and from school.
- Continue to maintain and further develop a student-centered technology infrastructure.
- Improve services and the financial well-being of nutrition services.

District Communication Efforts

The following was accomplished in parent involvement during the 2008-2009 school year in support of the Washoe County School District's (WCSD) Blueprint for Student Success.

The District's Parent Involvement Council (PIC) is supported by the District's Parent Involvement Coordinator and charged with providing input on district policy and district-wide initiatives for family engagement. The District's PIC had numerous successes including:

- Completion of a district-wide assessment on parent involvement with individual school reports and a district report published online.
- Quarterly Parent Leader Roundtables.
- Family friendly walk-throughs and follow-up reports.

The District partnered with University of Nevada, Reno – College of Education, and the Nevada State PIRC to implement a pre-service teacher seminar. Superintendent Dugan offered Brown Bag Lunch opportunities for parents and the community to facilitate two-way communication with parents. The District's Hispanic Liaison hosted monthly Family Learning Nights specifically tailored to our Hispanic Community. Workshops were held at familiar locations to provide better outreach to families. A Spanish hotline was established, providing information about upcoming classes and events.

The Education Alliance was in its third year of implementing the five-year, \$3.1 million dollar federal Parent Information & Resource Center (PIRC) statewide grant. Staff members provided services and trainings on research based programs in Reno, Elko and Las Vegas. Edline kiosks were implemented throughout the community in libraries and community locations, providing parents without technology, access to their child's grades and attendance. Thirty-four Parent Involvement Facilitators funded through Title I and SB185 grants provide daily support to parents at our most at-risk schools. The PIFs are supported by the District's Title I Office and Parent Involvement Office with professional development on various topics.
