In accordance with board regulation, your child has been referred to the Violence Intervention Program.

The program is taught by state licensed school counselors, teachers and marriage and family therapists as well as school police officers and detectives.

The classes are:

WHEN:	Thursday Evenings (except on Holidays) from 7-9PM
Where:	HUG HIGH SCHOOL BUILDING "C"

Students are required to attend the Violence Intervention classes with a parent or guardian. It is not a place that is appropriate to bring babies and young children.

The program is not conducted in a disciplinary fashion but is rather a learning and educational opportunity in lieu of further suspension.

The classes are designed to provide your child with a new beginning and to encourage them to process behavioral choices.

The goal is to increase parent and student dialogue about violence in hopes to prevent further occurrences.
