Notes From The Principal

The change in parent pick-up and drop-off procedures which began in January has been generally received positively by parents. This change was made to create a safer environment for our children around the school. Now we need your help to continue our work to keep Dodson safe for students. When dropping off and picking up students before and after school, please be sure to obey all traffic laws and some common sense procedures. Most importantly, remember that the posted speed limit at that time is 15 miles per hour. Maintaining this speed is one way to make sure that everyone stays safe. Also, be aware of our crossing guards. They are a group of responsible students who have volunteered to help their fellow Dodson students cross the street safely.

In addition, please follow other traffic laws by parking legally along the curb. The curb along Jake Street is open for parking as is the curb around the entire school. If making a U-turn, please be sure to do so following traffic laws.

Some things that you can do to avoid traffic citations as well as to help us be good neighbors to the people living on the street surrounding the school are; avoid parking in neighbor's driveways, pull to the curb rather than stopping in the middle of the road to drop off students, and don't park in front of fire hydrants. Please be sure to always consider the safety of all of our students whenever driving around Dodson.
