This report contains parent responses to the WCSD Parent Climate Survey regarding your school, administered in May 2011. Further analysis and detail will follow in early fall 2011.

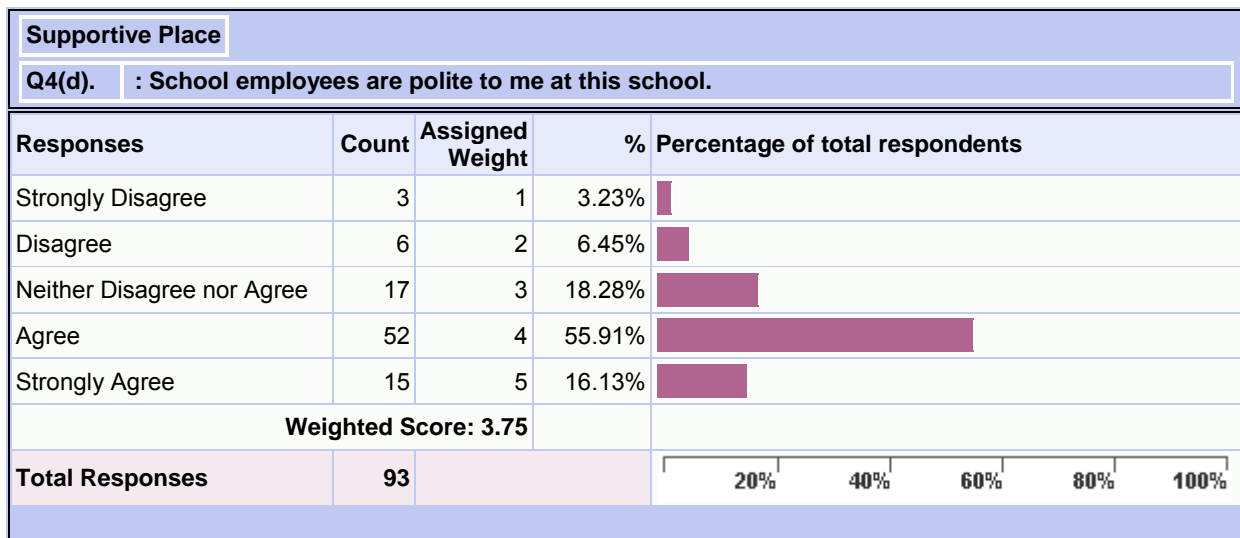
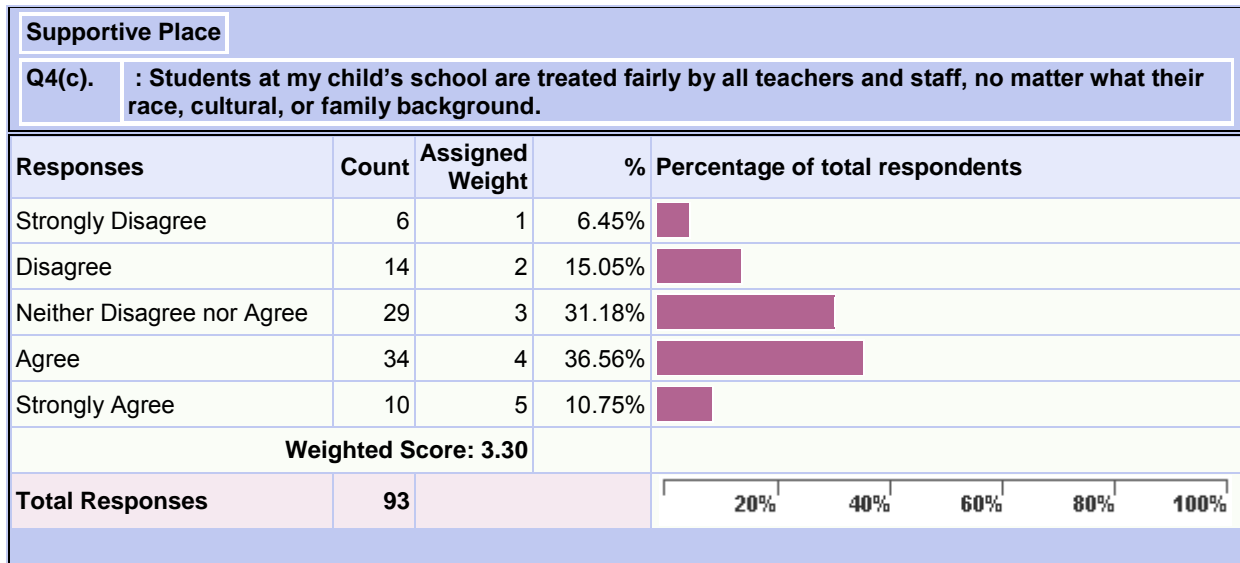
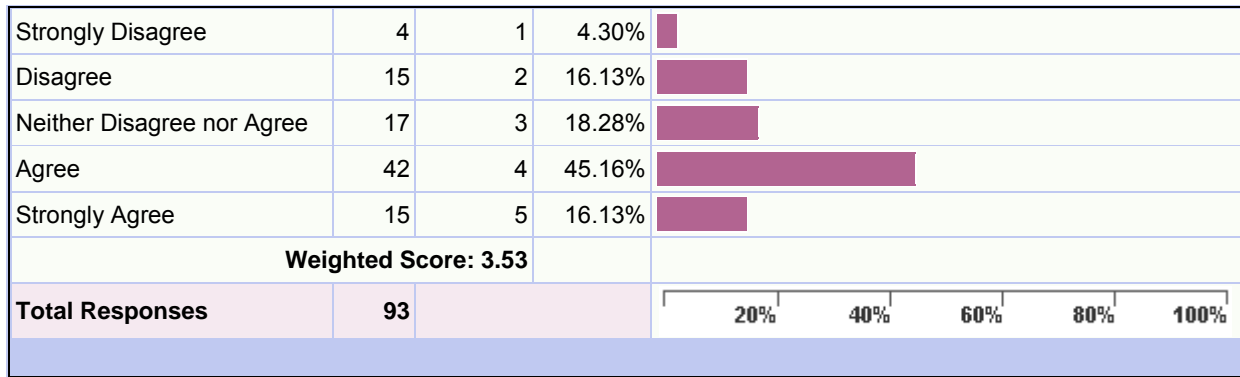
Notes
