STUDENT-ATHLETE ELIGIBILITY

2010-2011 Grade Check Dates

Sept. 17, Oct. 8, Oct. 28, Nov. 19, Dec. 10, Jan. 21

Feb. 11, Mar. 4, Mar. 25, Apr. 22, May. 13

- 1) Notification of the upcoming **ACADEMIC** grade check date to the teaching staff will be made a week prior to the official date.
- 2) On grade check day (listed above), the teacher will notify the athletic secretary if an athlete has an F (below 60%) in his/her class. The notification to the athletic secretary must be by **email or in writing prior to your leaving school on Friday**. The student-athlete will be placed on PROBATIONARY status.
- 3) PROBATIONARY status: The student-athlete may play and travel during this week. He/she must work with the respective teacher to raise his/her grade to a D- or higher during the probationary week.
- 4) By Friday of the probationary week, if the student-athlete raises his/her grade to a D- or higher, the teacher will notify the athletic secretary. If the teacher does not notify the athletic secretary, the student will be placed on INELIGIBILITY status for the next week.
- 5) INELIGIBILITY status: The student-athlete may not play or travel during this week. He/she must work with the respective teacher to raise his/her grade to a D- or higher or ineligibility will continue.
- 6) The probationary/ineligibility week runs from Monday through Saturday. Note: **If a student-athlete becomes eligible early in the week, he/she will continue to remain on probationary/ineligible status until Monday of the next week.**
