

Lemmon Valley School Wide Positive Behavior Plan



Lemmon Valley students are respectful, responsible, and safe on the bus.

Progressive Discipline Plan

1. Teachers at Lemmon Valley Elementary will teach/re-teach bus expectations once a quarter.
2. Bus Drivers will follow the same expectations for Lemmon Valley students by teaching and posting the PAWS Matrix on the bus.
3. Bus drivers will need to have a seating chart for all students riding the bus and give a copy to administration at Lemmon Valley Elementary. The original should be done in pencil; this will make it easier to change assignments if necessary. Notify administration of changes.
4. Bus drivers will need to have an attendance chart for his/her route in the AM and PM starting the 1st day of school.
5. Bus drivers will follow a positive behavior approach to discipline.
 - a. **5 positives to every 1 negative for every student**
 - i. Positive Praise
 - ii. **Leaping Leopards**
 - iii. Treats
 - iv. Radio on
 - v. Individual driver's incentives
 - b. Follow a step-by-step approach to inappropriate behavior (Document behavior on Lemmon Valley Progressive Bus Discipline Document)
 - i. 1st: Verbal warning
 - ii. 2nd: Leaping Leopards: 5 positives before the next negative consequence
 - iii. 3rd: Give student a copy of the PAWS Matrix for bus expectations with a blank copy on the back. The student will take it home and fill in the blank copy of the expectations for appropriate behavior and return it the next day to the bus driver in exchange for a Leaping Leopard.
 - iv. 4th: Conduct Report: Notify Administration at Lemmon Valley
 - v. 5th: Citation: Notify Administration at Lemmon Valley
 - vi. 6th: Conduct Report: Notify Administration at Lemmon Valley
 - vii. 7th: 2nd Citation: Notify Administration at Lemmon Valley
 - viii. 8th: 3rd Citation: Notify Administration at Lemmon Valley
 - ix. Suspension from bus- Administration discretion at any level of severity.
 - c. Other consequences from driver/supervisor for inappropriate behavior
 - i. Change of seat
 - ii. Talk to student
 - iii. Remind student(s) to refer to the PAWS Matrix for expected behavior on the bus. Lemmon Valley students are respectful, responsible, and safe on the bus.
