

RTI Academics

RTI academics is a system that focuses on providing high quality and appropriate instruction to all students, as well as the early identification of at-risk students, grades Pre-K-12.

Components of RTI Academics

1. A 3-tiered system utilizing a problem-solving process that supports all students across the performance continuum.
2. Scientific, research based instruction and interventions implemented with fidelity that result in student progress for all students.
3. Progress monitoring
4. Decision-making based on multiple sources of data

Critical Features

1. Utilization of a problem-solving process
 - a. Problem identification (*What is the problem?*)
 - b. Problem analysis (*Why is it occurring?*)
 - c. Intervention Plan (*What are we going to do about it?*)
 - d. Plan evaluation (*Did what we did about it result in success?*)
2. Evaluating tier 1 (core instruction based on the following acronym):
 - a. Instruction (*Are 80% of students responding to instruction?*)
 - b. Curriculum (*Is the curriculum being implemented with fidelity?*)
 - c. Environment (*How are classroom management skills? Are expectations clear?*)
 - d. Learner (*Once the ICE is ruled-out what is happening with the student?*)
3. Use of a three-tiered process
 - a. Tier 1 (*Core/standards based instruction for all learners*)
 - b. Tier 2 (*Targeted group supports based on problem solving interventions*)
 - c. Tier 3 (*Non-responders to tier 2 and much more individualized*)
