A VARIETY OF INTERNSHIPS

The Internship Class is for juniors and seniors who have at least a 3.0 GPA overall and are enrolled in AP/Honors courses OR for juniors and seniors who are GATE certified. An intern earns a half credit by completing 86 hours with a mentor who works in a career the intern is considering. Interns may earn up to four ½ credits during their junior and senior years. Transportation is not provided.

In addition to finding out what one does or does not want to do for a living, some additional benefits of an internship are college acceptance, scholarships, professional references, and future jobs
