In the SSSHS bowling club, students learn the fundamentals of bowling. They participate in a weekly practice session, and a weekly competition against another school. This program offers two levels of participation; intramural and competitive. The competitive team’s season culminates in the High Desert Interscholastic Bowling Program (HDIBP) championship. It is open to all SSSHS students. Season is 8 to 9 weeks long, December through February or the first week of March. Cost to students averages \$60.00 which covers bowling fees, a team shirt with school logo, shoe rental, and Young American Bowling Alliance (YABA) dues. Students must provide their own transportation to and from both practices and matches, and must maintain a GPA of at least 2.0 to remain eligible.
